ORDINANCE NO. 1516

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GRINNELL, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO OPERATIONS OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Grinnell, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 75.05, Subsection 6, Item J of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grinnell, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

75.05 OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES. The operators of ATVs shall comply with the following restrictions as to where ATVs may be operated within the City:

6. Exception for Snow Removal.

J. A City Certificate of Registration must be carried on the ATV being operated on streets under this subsection.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
