The final commission meeting of 2021 was called to order by Chairperson Neubert at 7:00 pm.

Members present were: Chair Neubert, JR Paulson, Tom Grabinski and Mary Schuchmann.


Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as submitted.

New Business: Discussion was had relative to downtown facade grants and additional work that has been earmarked. Additions to work previously discussed are: The old Bill's Jewelry building, Frontier Cafe, Beckman Gallery, Cirsi Building and Bates Flowers by Design. No action was needed.

Significant discussion was also had relative to the Historic District in north Grinnell. The Paulson carriage house style garage planned for next year was announced. Tax credits for work on contributing homes was briefly discussed. The consensus was that it would be helpful for the commission to sponsor workshops for owners of historic homes to introduce both new and more tenured historic home owners to the care and preservation of the houses' attributes. No official action was taken in this regard.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00.
