Media Release

On July 17, 2015, at approximately 10:00 a.m., Grinnell officers responded Jeld-Wen on a report of a hit and run motor vehicle crash. Officer's Fricke and Reinhard found a Chevy Impala with significant damage, while the other vehicle had fled the scene. The officers were able to identify that the fleeing vehicle was a Chevy Uplander, based on a body part number taken from a piece of the vehicle that had been left behind.

Shortly before 11:00 a.m., while checking the area, Ofc. Fricke observed a Chevy Uplander, with damage, being operated in the Wal-Mart parking lot. Officer's Fricke and Reinhard stopped the vehicle, which had been reported stolen out of the Iowa City area, and made contact with the driver identified as Jordan Sedlock, age 25, of Grinnell. Based on the officer's investigation, Jordan Sedlock was arrested and later lodged in the Poweshiek County Jail pending an initial court appearance.

Jordan Sedlock has been charged with the following offenses:

Driving while license denied, suspended, cancelled or revoked - Simple Misdemeanor
Leaving the Scene of an Accident - Property Damage only - Simple Misdemeanor
Operating While Under the Influence 2nd Offense - Aggravated Misdemeanor
Theft 2nd Degree - Class D Felony

A criminal charge is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
