We have found that Sundays offer the least amount of conflict with other local events. It also allows more families to come enjoy the show together as the kids are not busy with their extracurricular activities.

The proposal below is the same request that was approved for 2019 which had an amazing turn out (despite the rain) and went over very well! The red bars on the attached map represent where the barricades shall be located. As you can see, we plan to use Commercial (to the alley, Broad St, 3<sup>rd</sup> St, and Park as we have in the past. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue shall remain open for traffic flow.

Our Treasurer, Bud Cox, has already spoken to the Police Department and Chief Reilly referred us to Officer Zach Sitig to discuss any concerns they may have. Officer Sitig agreed that leaving 4<sup>th</sup> Ave open would be good but expressed no other concerns.


