MINUTES

Bernemann called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. with members Appleton, Bernemann, and Thompson present. Absent: Miller.

The agenda was approved as presented.

Chief Sicard and Asst. Chief Duffy presented an overview and timeline of the current process for testing and hiring of individuals for the position of Firefighter/EMT. Applications are currently being accepted, testing on August 11/12, with background checks, secondary interviews and MFPRSI physicals of candidates to follow. The current plan is to hire 6 individuals -- two immediately with up to four more to be hired later.

The Commission approved the testing process as presented. After additional discussion, it was agreed that if further testing is needed to get additional candidates, the department can proceed with testing as needed.

The commission then moved on to interview a police officer candidate. Blake Honeycutt was interviewed by the commission.

Following the interview, motion by Appleton, second by Bernemann, to place the candidate's name on a Civil Service hiring list for a Police Officer position. AYES: 2-0. Motion carried.

There was no old business or inquiries.

The meeting adjourned at 4:24 p.m.
