tax preparation for low to moderate income taxpayers. Electronic filing can be done by IRS certified volunteers for both federal and state returns.

Who Qualifies: Individuals and families whose incomes are \$57,000 or less

Returns that may include any of the following cannot be done through this service: farm income, rental income, contract sale of property, business operating expenses exceeding \$25,000, depreciation schedules, moving expenses, debt cancellation due to bankruptcy, or loss from a business
