

Poweshiek Transfer Station Offers Recycling for Clean Asphalt Shingles

Who can participate?

Roofing companies and contractors in good standing with SCISWA

Residents re-roofing their own homes

How do we start?

Separate asphalt shingles from other debris as you remove roofing material. Deliver shingles and debris to the Transfer Station. Follow staff directions for unloading materials in the correct areas.

What about asbestos?

Shingles from **single family homes** are not required to be tested for asbestos. You will be asked to sign a form documenting the address of the home.

For shingles from **commercial buildings** (businesses & multi-family residences larger than a four-plex), the contractor must provide a certification form and test results confirming the shingles do not contain asbestos.

Delivery Requirements and Price List

Clean Asphalt Shingles

Clean asphalt shingles include the nails, felt, and tar paper attached to them when removed from the roof.

A drop-off is available adjacent to the shingle recycling area for scrap metal, including flashing, gutters, and metal plumbing stacks. These must be separated.

Contaminants

Wood, pallets

Wood shake shingles

Plastic and vinyl: vents, gutters, buckets, packaging

Paper waste

Mastic or plastic roofing cement

Rolled roofing material (extra felt)

Nail coils

Other garbage, trash, or dirt

Contaminants must be handled as waste. SCISWA will check incoming shingle loads and may charge the full disposal rate for contaminated loads.

placed in Shingle Recycling Area

Mixed Construction & Demolition Debris \$59.00

Handled as waste;
Dropped in Transfer Station
